TRINITY

We have our book that tells us a lot about God. In this book we are taught some things about God. We know that He is big...powerful...loving...creates things and He has many different kinds of Sons and Daughters. You and I are sons and daughters of God. He loves us!

He likes the shape of circles, doesn't He? Let's consider the sun \sim the moon \sim our own planets and all of those we see from Hubble.



God is ONE yet He is also THREE. All three parts move independently yet are still ONE. The word Trinity means 'three in one'. The center circle is God the Father. The next inner circle is God the Son. The outer circle is God the Spirit. They all do different things yet they all came from God the Father. (Hence, the TRINITY 'spins' independent of one another)

Our Paradise Father (God) is the Father of all things. Because of His love He wanted to share His life with others. Long, long ago 'back in eternity' (what an interesting concept) God decided to create His Eternal Son (the second circle). And this Eternal Son is where our Jesus comes from. Then God decided to create the Holy Infinite Spirit (the 3rd circle) and this is where our Mother Spirit and Her angels come from. God, our Paradise Father, does certain things. The Eternal Son works and does specific things like what Jesus did/does for us. The Infinite Spirit, who is 'mind', along with Her angels do other things for us. They watch over us and guide our steps as we live our lives. All of the these unseen friends love you and me. They are assisting us in coming closer to our Paradise Father. We may choose to love them right back.

Question:

What do ice water, steam and liquid water have in common?

What can ice water achieve?

What can steam accomplish?

What is the benefit of liquid water?

This is a perfect material example of a substance like water in 3 different expressions.

Passage: 53:5.4 Since Michael elected to remain aloof from the actual warfare of the Lucifer rebellion (Michael will never harm His own children/creations), Gabriel called his personal staff together on

Edentia and, in counsel with the Most Highs, elected to assume command of the loyal hosts of Satania. Michael remained on Salvington while Gabriel proceeded to Jerusem, and establishing himself on the sphere dedicated to the Father — the same Universal Father whose personality Lucifer and Satan had questioned — in the presence of the forgathered hosts of loyal personalities, he displayed the banner of Michael, the material emblem of the Trinity government of all creation, the three azure blue concentric circles on a white background.

When was the first time that you thought about/considered the Trinity?

Passage: 93:2.5 In personal appearance, Melchizedek resembled the then blended Nodite and Sumerian peoples, being almost six feet in height and possessing a commanding presence. He spoke Chaldean and a half dozen other languages. He dressed much as did the Canaanite priests except that on his breast he wore an emblem of three concentric circles, the Satania symbol of the Paradise Trinity. In the course of his ministry this insignia of three concentric circles became regarded as so sacred by his followers that they never dared to use it, and it was soon forgotten with the passing of a few generations.

Is there some material symbol you hold dear to your heart? Does it represent a relationship of some sort? Our Father is 'relational'. This is why He created the other 2 parts of His Trinity. He wanted to share love. This is why He created YOU to love as well.

Passages: ^{1:0.1} THE Universal Father is the God of all creation, the First Source and Center of all things and beings. First think of God as a creator, then as a controller, and lastly as an infinite upholder. The truth about the Universal Father had begun to dawn upon mankind when the prophet said: "You, God, are alone; there is none beside you. You have created the heaven and the heaven of heavens, with all their hosts; you preserve and control them. By the Sons of God were the universes made. The Creator covers himself with light as with a garment and stretches out the heavens as a curtain." Only the concept of the Universal Father — one God in the place of many gods — enabled mortal man to comprehend the Father as divine creator and infinite controller.

6:1.1 The Eternal Son is the original and only-begotten Son of God. He is God the Son, the Second Person of Deity and the associate creator of all things. As the Father is the First Great Source and Center, so the Eternal Son is the Second Great Source and Center.

^{8:0.1} BACK in eternity, when the Universal Father's "first" infinite and absolute thought finds in the Eternal Son such a perfect and adequate word for its divine expression, there ensues the supreme desire of both the Thought-God and the Word-God for a universal and infinite agent of mutual expression and combined action. ^{8:0.3} We are now face to face with the eternity origin of the Infinite Spirit, the Third Person of Deity.

10:0.2 The Trinity is Deity unity, and this unity rests eternally upon the absolute foundations of the divine oneness of the three original and co-ordinate and coexistent personalities, God the Father, God the Son, and God the Spirit.

Consider spending some quiet time with your indwelling Trinity of Father (your Thought Adjuster),
Son (your Spirit of Truth) and Mother Spirit (your mind).
Faith is all that is required!
